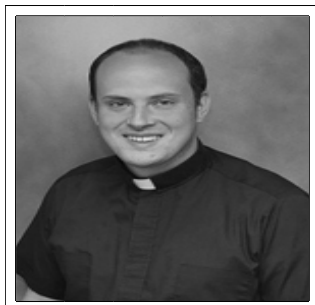
After ordination in June 2017, I spent the last 15 months in another Washington, Washington PA. I gained a lot of experience and good friends at our fellow county seat to the south.
